How can I contribute to advancing justice, equity, diversity, and inclusion in aquatic sciences through my individual choices and actions?

- Use gender-neutral language (they, folks, y'all, etc.).
- Ask how to pronounce someone's name.
- Use a pronoun ribbon and respect the pronouns of others.
- Reach out to a new society member.
- Visit the Student Headquarters.
- Visit a JEDI-related poster or oral presentation.
- Diversity comes in many forms respect them all.
 Understand that diversity can sometimes be invisible (e.g., non-visible disabilities, some LGBTQIA identities, ethnicity, and language, etc.).
- Identify the ways in which you are privileged: in society, culture, academia etc.
- Commit to continuous improvement. Be willing to learn, accept feedback, and listen to the concerns of those around you. All of us can find opportunities for growth.
- · Pause and consider any assumptions you may be making.
- Welcome ideas that are different from your own.
